In order to fund your child's Head Start or Early Head Start program we must receive 25% of our funding from local donations of time, money, materials, and services. This funding source is called In-Kind. This means we need help from parents and the local community to operate our Head Start program. Parent involvement in their child's education is key to their future success, and In-Kind is a great way to be involved.

 - Share a meal with your child
 - Share a hobby or talent
 - Prepare or donate materials for the classroom
- Complete activities provided by your EHS Family Education Specialist as listed on the Lesson Plan or prepare materials for the home visit activity
